

Taj Mahal, Agra



Kerala Back Waters, Kerala


Backwaters in Kerala is a network of 1500 km of canals both man made and natural, 38 rivers and 5 big lakes extending from one end of Kerala to the other.



Golden Temple, Amritsar



Tirumala Venkateswara, Tirupati

The Temple is dedicated to Lord Sri Venkateswara, an incarnation of Vishnu who is believed to have appeared here to save mankind. It is the richest temple in the world in terms of donations received and wealth. The temple is visited by about 50,000 to 100,000 pilgrims daily (30 to 40 million people annually on average), while on special occasions and festivals, like the annual Brahmotsavam, the number of pilgrims shoots up to 500,000, making it the most-visited holy place in the world.

Udvada Fire Temple, Bihar

This place of worship is the oldest still-functioning example of its kind, and has established Udvada as a

pilgrimage center for Zoroastrians the world over. The Udvada Atash Behram is the most sacred of the Zoroastrian fire temples in India and the oldest continuously burning fire-temple in the world.


